Acceptance of the Minutes of the previous meeting were proposed by David Hewick and seconded by Hugh Begg.

There were no matters arising from the Minutes.

There were no police in attendance and no matters to be dealt with.

There was discussion of the possibility of closure of the level crossing at Broughty Ferry Station in Gray Street. It was agreed that this would be detrimental to Broughty Ferry as a shopping destination and that the Community Council should liaise closely with other, particularly the Traders before reaching a position. Carole Jenkins agreed to arrange a meeting which would bring together all of the bodies concerned in an effort to reach a positive solution to the current situation.

George Ferguson will forward an e-mail he has received regarding the latest Network Rail proposals for Broughty Station platform. Members were invited to respond to him within seven days of receipt in order that the replies can be collated and forwarded to the appropriate body.

The Vice-Chair had sent out by e-mail a report summarising his proposed activities for the forthcoming year. These proposals were accepted unanimously..

Stan Nutt gave a report on the licensing correspondence received.

The Treasurer, David Easson, had submitted his apologies. There e was no treasurer's report but George informed everyone that the cheque for £551.00 from the Council has been received and will be passed on.

David Hewick gave his usual full report on planning matters with regards to Sainsbury, 477 Brook Street which has now been withdrawn, Conversion of Eastern School. 14 Church Street, and 11 Victoria Road, where a £20,000.00 bond has been required to insure against damage to trees.

There was a request from a local resident that the Community Council look into the condition of the 'phone boxes. With that in min George to write to BT.
