However, the windows of the extension should not be "mock" windows. They should be proper working timber sash windows. The window to be opened up should also be similar. In addition, the slates on the roof should be natural slates.

Internally, there is extra dining space created and an additional female W/C, which is an improvement. It should be ensured that the relocated disabled W/C is readily accessible.

We trust that adequate beer garden space will remain.
