We wish to object to this application as the design is unsatisfactory for the location in a conservation area.

It is proposed to put a dormer on one side of the roof on the front elevation of a Victorian tenement. There are a number of problems with this dormer.

- 1. It is too large for the limited amount of (shallow) roof available. Consequently it will adversely impinge on views from the street.
- 2. It unbalances the symmetry of the tenement.
- 3. The window should be of a sash and case design.

Additionally, the roof light proposed on the rear elevation is far too large and out of keeping with the existing rooflights.
