

Creating Biodiversity Grasslands and Naturalised Grasslands in Dundee's Parks and Greenspaces - A Consultation



Dundee City Council recently proposed that a number of areas within parks and greenspaces could be identified as potential biodiversity grasslands and naturalised grasslands. These potential locations were left uncut over the summer and signage erected informing users of the Council's intentions. A review of these sites is now underway and a citywide survey to gather the views of residents about these areas has been launched.
