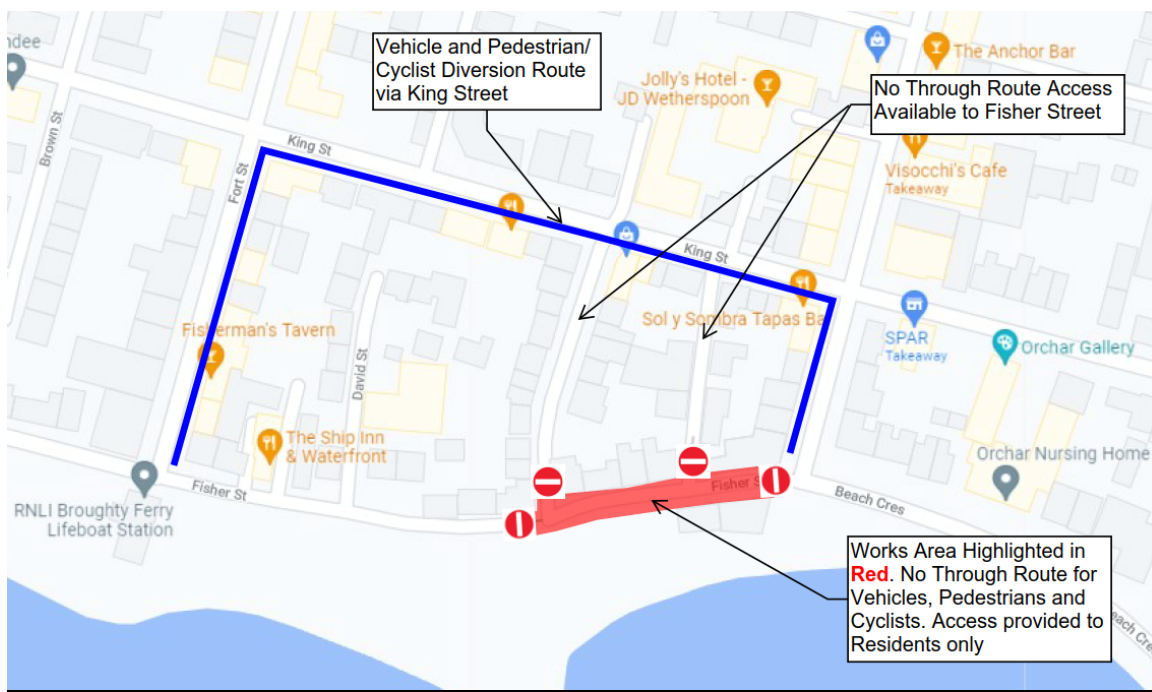

To whom it may concern,

In accordance with the Flood Risk Management (Scotland) Act 2009, we hereby notify you that McLaughlin & Harvey will continue construction works of the Broughty Ferry Flood Protection Scheme on **Fisher Street**. As part of works being carried out, the footpath and road carriageway will temporarily be adjusted in this area please refer to the map and below.



These works will commence on **Thursday 4th November** on the road carriageway and south footpath on Fisher Street. There will be **NO** vehicular, pedestrian or cyclist through route access to Fisher Street, Bath Street or Ambrose Street whilst the works are ongoing. Diversion will be in place as detailed above via King Street. Pedestrian access will always be provided to the residents of the affected properties. Full works will last approx. **5 weeks** with Pedestrian/Cyclist through route access resumed after **3 weeks**.
